**SCHOOL BOND ELECTION
CASS COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT 0032
(LOUISVILLE PUBLIC SCHOOLS)
IN THE STATE OF NEBRASKA**

"Shall Cass County School District 0032 (Louisville Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska issue its bonds in a total principal amount not to exceed \$37,250,000 for the purposes of financing the costs of (a) constructing a Career and Technical Education building and related site improvements, (b) constructing an addition to the District's existing school building and related site improvements, which will include new classrooms and a new gymnasium, (c) renovating and improving certain portions of the existing school building and premises, including safety and security updates, a new secure entry, and renovations of the kitchen and cafeteria area, classrooms and the existing gymnasium, and (d) purchasing certain equipment, furniture and apparatus for such buildings and additions; said bonds to be issued from time to time, to be sold at such prices, to bear interest at such rates, to become due at such times, and to have such other terms and provisions, all as may be fixed and determined by the Board of Education of the District; and

"Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of, the premium, if any, and the interest on said bonds as the same become due?"

LANCASTER COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT 0145
(Waverly School District 145)
IN THE STATE OF NEBRASKA**

"Shall Lancaster County School District 0145 (Waverly School District 145) in the State of Nebraska (the "District") issue general obligation bonds of the District in an aggregate stated principal amount not to exceed Eighty Nine Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$89,900,000), for the purpose of providing funds to pay the costs of additions, renovations and improvements of the District's existing buildings and facilities, and providing furniture, equipment and apparatus for the same, which may include the following: security and technology additions and improvements; heating, ventilation and cooling improvements and upgrades; reconfiguration of existing facilities and replacement of furnishings and equipment; and additions, renovations and improvements to the existing buildings and facilities for or related to the High School, Middle School, Intermediate School, Hamlow Elementary School and Eagle Elementary School buildings; such bonds to be issued from time to time, to bear interest at such rate or rates, to be sold at such prices and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by, or determined at the direction of, the Board of Education; and

"Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due?"

"Shall Cass County School District 0056 (Conestoga Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska issue its bonds in a total principal amount not to exceed \$33,000,000 for the purposes of financing the costs of:

- Improving safety and security at each of the existing elementary and junior/senior high school buildings including, but not limited to, constructing secured entrances and storm shelters;
- Improving existing classrooms, restrooms and other areas for students with disabilities within the junior/senior high school building;
- Constructing additions to and renovations of the junior/senior school building including, but not limited to, general classrooms, career and technical education classrooms, and related site improvements;
- Constructing additions to and renovations of the elementary school building including, but not limited to, general classrooms and related site improvements; and
- Purchasing certain necessary equipment, furniture and apparatus for such buildings and additions;

said bonds to be issued from time to time, to be sold at such prices, to bear interest at such rates, to become due at such times, and to have such other terms and provisions, all as may be fixed and determined by the Board of Education of the District; and

"Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of, the premium, if any, and the interest on said bonds as the same become due?"
