

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I register to vote? Change my party affiliation? Change my address?

- The easiest way is to go to the Nebraska Secretary of State web page and under the Quick links on the left is a link that will take you to their on-line registration site.

- Or contact the election office to request a form or [click here](#) to download a voter registration form.
- The completed form with original signature must be mailed or delivered to the Election Commissioner at the address stated below.

What qualifications are there for a person to vote in any election in Cass County?

- A qualified voter must be a United States citizen
- Must be 18 or older on the day of the General Election (first Tuesday, after first Monday in November).
- A resident of Cass County.
- Not convicted of a felony, unless your civil rights have been restored or it has been 2 years after the sentence is completed, including any parole term.
- Not declared mentally incompetent

How do I find out where to vote for an election.

- By calling the election office at 402-296-9309
- Search the Secretary of State site at: <https://www.votercheck.necvr.ne.gov>

What should I do if I have moved since the last election?

- You must update your voter registration to reflect your new/current address.
- Follow the directions above under How do I register to vote?

Does a person have to go to a voting place in order to cast a vote during any election?

- No. Early Voting Ballots are available from the election office *by mail* 35 days prior to the election [click here](#) to download a request form, sign and return via mail, fax, or email. Requests can be accepted 120 prior to any election.
- Or simply come *in person*, 30 days prior to the election and request a ballot at the election office. The last day to mail a ballot is the close of business on the second Friday preceding the election.

How can a person find out when the next election will be held?

- On the election web-page select
> Special Elections or 2018 Elections
- Or by calling the Election Office

How can a person find out which offices will be up for election?

- On the election web-page select
>2018 Elections then select
>Offices Up for Election
- Or call the Election Office
- For local races you can also contact your Village and City Clerks

How can a person file as a delegate for their Party County Convention?

- A delegate filing form must be completed and filed in my office by March 3. [Click here](#) to download a form
- Once the party chairperson certifies the date, time, and location for their party convention (due by May 1st) a Certificate of Election for Delegate to the Convention will be mailed out.

How can a person file as a candidate for an office for an upcoming election?

- Detailed information for an office can be found on the election web-page by selecting
>2018 Offices up for Election then,
>Select the office in question to find information about that office
- Under Forms, select the Candidate Filing Form to download
