

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I register to vote? Change my party affiliation? Change my address?

- Online at <https://sos.nebraska.gov> Elections-Voters-Register to Vote (if you are not registered in the state of Nebraska) or Update Voter Registration (if you are already registered to vote in the state of Nebraska)
- **OR** Print the Voter Registration Application (located in forms) fill out and return by mail or bring into the election office.
- **OR** Come into the election office.

What qualifications are there for a person to vote in any election in Cass County?

- Must be a United States citizen
- Must be 18 or older on the day of the General Election (first Tuesday, after first Monday in November).
- A resident of Cass County.
- Not convicted of a felony, unless your civil rights have been restored or it has been 2 years after the sentence is completed, including any parole term.
- Not declared mentally incompetent

How do I find out where to vote for an election?

What should I do if I have moved since the last election?

- You must update your voter registration to reflect your new/current address.
- Follow the directions above under How do I register to vote?

How can a person find out when the next election will be held?

- Nebraska's Elections are held in May and November in EVEN numbered years.
- The Primary is held the 1st Tuesday after the 2nd Monday in May.
- The General is held the 1st Tuesday after the 1st Monday in November.

I do not want to go to my polling location on Election Day, I will not be in town on Election Day, How can I still vote?

- You can request an early voting ballot by mail. The Early Voting Ballot Application can be found under forms. You will need to fill out the form, sign it and return to the election office by mail, email, fax or drop off at the office. Request can be accepted 120 days prior to any election and the ballots will start being mailed 35 days prior to the election. The last day we can mail a ballot, is the 3rd Friday preceding the election.
- 30 days prior to the election, you can come into the office and request your ballot. You can vote right in the office or take your ballot with you and return to the office.
